I'm pleased to report yet another record-breaking year for the Utah Local Governments Trust and its members. Fifty entities joined our pooled programs in 2016, including: St. George City, Logan City, Utah Municipal Power Agency, and 47 others. Member retention has been above 99% for more than five years. Last year, the Trust trimmed operating expenses by

more than \$1,600,000, a reduction of 8%. We expanded coverage and are providing more services than ever before. We returned \$3,000,000 to members in dividends and rate stabilization, and strengthened our net position by \$3,510,656.

The Trust helps you achieve your goals to reduce loss and injury. If results are better than actuarial projections, members reap the reward through dividends, premium subsidies, more coverage for less premium, and increased financial security.
