# The Trust is Partner of Choice for 73% of Utah's Local Governments, with 99.6% Member Retention

CEO MESSAGE



The year 2017 was record-breaking for the Utah Local Governments Trust. After carefully studying options, 65 new members joined our pooled programs. In addition, scores of members bid out their insurance, thoughtfully comparing terms, conditions, services, and pricing. Not surprisingly, 99.6% chose to continue their partnership with the Trust. In fact, five-year member retention is north of 99%.

In 2017, we expanded our liability coverage and added pollution and crime coverage at no additional cost. We returned \$1,000,000 to members in premium relief credit. We paid \$19,591,226 in claims and expenses. Still, we strengthened our net position by \$6,751,405. This money will benefit members directly through continued rate reductions, premium stabilization and offsets, expanded coverage, enhanced services, and more premium relief credits. In the end, we're delivering more for less, and strengthening financial security to weather future storms.

The Trust is you – we're in this together. Loss Prevention is helping you achieve your goals to reduce loss and injury. Marketing is simplifying insurance so you can easily evaluate options. Claims is helping resolve difficult situations. Underwriting is using mathematical models and data analytics to spread the cost of risk in a fair and sustainable way. Technical Services and Accounting continue to be innovative in meeting your needs.

Since 1974, the Trust has provided specialized insurance products and services to Utah's local governments. Today, the Trust has insuring relationships with 533 members: 91% of Utah's Cities and Towns, 65% of Utah's Local and Special Districts, and 38% of Utah's Counties. We compete directly with the commercial market and other insurance providers. We're here because we deliver what they cannot. Members have options. Still, nearly 100% of members renew annually because of our superior financial security, coverage, loss prevention, and lower overall cost of risk.


